

Our family moved to the Orcutt Area in 1992. We have loved the peaceful area and have chosen to continue to live here in retirement. The addition of the Union Valley Parkway extension has been a blessing for many to access both Highways 101 and 135. As a frequent traveler both morning and evening, I have come to realize the increased traffic at the corner of Hummel and UVP. This intersection is very dangerous with the UVP traffic traveling at freeway speeds. I urge those with concerns to contact me as I petition the county roads to install a 4 way stop to control this intersection. I fear that there will be additional accidents and that one of our family members will be killed trying to cross this dangerous intersection.

Roundabout Considered for Clark & Foxenwood Lane



To improve traffic circulation and safety, the County Public Works Department is looking at significant changes from Foxenwood Lane to Norris Street on Clark Avenue. The Board of Supervisors approved a preliminary design study regarding a roundabout near Norris Street and Clark Avenue.

Chris Sneddon, Deputy Director of Transportation says, "a roundabout will improve traffic circulation and safety at Clark Avenue and Norris Street. Additionally, this project will help slow traffic and will create an opportunity for an Orcutt gateway feature in the center." Currently, drivers encounter a quick merge into one lane as they are headed into Old Town Orcutt. The project will also accommodate left turns onto Foxenwood lane from Clark Avenue. He adds the County receives complaints about traffic speeds in the area.

A second project involves adding a median between the roundabout and Highway 135. Sneddon explains, "If you are driving westbound on Clark Avenue into Old Town Orcutt, you currently merge into one lane. We will move the merge under Highway 135 so that the space between Highway 135 and Foxenwood

Lane will be one lane, making room for the median." The median will also offer options for landscaping.

The Supervisors granted the contract to GHD International, with offices in San Luis Obispo, at a cost of \$86,000. The agreement will look at costs and engineering issues including the number of lanes in the roundabout. The median project will likely be the first of the two constructed. Sneddon hopes the roundabout design will be complete in 2024.

Larry Ferini Steps Down as Fourth District Planning Commissioner Local Grower Looks Back 11 Years of Service; Roy Reed to Replace Him

Choosing a planning commissioner can be the most significant decision a county supervisor makes. That choice affects decisions on major housing and industrial developments, environmental issues, even

During the County Planning Commission's last meeting in November, Fourth District Planning Commissioner Larry Ferini from Orcutt announced," I want to let my four fellow commissioners know that this will be my last month as planning commissioner for the fourth district."

Upon learning of the retirement, Ferini's close commissioner friend John Parke, representing the third district, commented, "You want to make me cry."

The outgoing commissioner says, "When former Fourth District Supervisor Peter Adam asked me to be his planning commissioner, I had been a farmer all my life. I had no idea what the position entails. County staff plopped stacks of documents in front of me and told me what I had to understand to get caught up."

Ferini operates Rancho Laguna Farms, growing organic strawberries,

blueberries, blackberries, raspberries and conventional cauliflower, broccoli, cilantro, celery, kale and iceberg lettuce. He is a 4th generation farmer who attended Santa Maria High School and Cal Poly. He holds a degree in crop science.

In reminiscing about some of the past planning commission decisions, Ferini said he enjoyed the friendships he cultivated with commissioners and county staff.

When asked about significant decisions he had been involved in, he said was disappointed in the 2022 approval of the housing development on Key Site 3 behind the Sunny Hills modular home park and south of Clark Avenue. "Two hundred

thirty-six homes were approved," he says. "In addition, an earlier affordable home project of 160 units had been approved for the site. There simply is not enough workforce to handle that many residents. At build out, commuting to Santa Barbara and Goleta will add traffic and pollution." Earlier, the county planning commission, with Ferini making the motion, denied the

In May of 2002, the denial was appealed to the Board of Supervisors. Over the objections of Fourth and Fifth District Supervisors Bob Nelson and Steve Lavagnini, the appeal was overturned and the project was approved, with three south county supervisors supporting the development on a three-two vote.

In deciding on a replacement for Ferini, Supervisor Bob Nelson chose Roy Reed, whose great-grandfathers Martin Luther Tunnell and Charles Bradley owned ranches in the Santa Maria Valley dating back to the 1880s. Since retiring from a career in pharmaceuticals, Reed has been managing family ranches, 2700 acres east of Santa Maria and smaller ranches along Foxen Canyon Road and in the Garey area where he worked with the county to promote responsible energy development.

Reed has been involved in several Santa Maria Valley non-profit organizations. Among them, he served as president of the Arthritis Foundation. He was co-founder




Incoming 4th District Planning Commissioner Roy Reed.

of the Alliance for Pharmaceutical Access (APA), an organization which assists lowerincome patients and those without drug insurance in obtaining the medicines they need to treat chronic conditions. Reed has most recently been board president of the Santa Barbara County Taxpayers Association.

Upon his retirement announcement, the Supervisors presented Ferini with a resolution honoring his "dedicated service to residents in the north county, especially the community of Orcutt." The last line of the resolution reads, "Whereas Larry Ferini in an all-around great human being as evidenced by his love of dogs, labradors in particular."
